

**SANTA CRUZ-MONTEREY-MERCED MANAGED
MEDICAL CARE COMMISSION**

TERM OF OFFICE - 4 YEARS

Established by Ordinance No. 1850, Board Meeting 11/18/2008. (Pursuant to California Welfare and Institutions Code Section 14087.54) Bylaws adopted on 6/9/2009.

PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVE

To negotiate exclusive contracts with the California Department of Health Care Services and to arrange for health care services to qualifying individuals in Santa Cruz , Monterey , and Merced Counties who lack sufficient annual income to meet the cost of health care, and whose other assets are so limited their application toward the cost of health care would jeopardize the person or family's future minimum self-maintenance and security.

MEMBERSHIP

Membership shall include 21 voting members, seven (7) residents of Santa Cruz County appointed by the Santa Cruz County Board of Supervisors, seven (7) residents of Monterey County appointed by Monterey County Board of Supervisors, and seven (7) residents of Merced County appointed by the Merced County Board of Supervisors:

Each of the three Counties representatives of:

1. Board of Supervisors member
2. Public Health Director/Administrator
3. Provider – At Large Appointment
4. Provider – At Large Appointment
5. Public Representative – At Large Appointment
6. Public Representative – (Shall be a past or present Medi-Cal beneficiary). At Large Appointment
7. Hospital Representative – At Large Appointment

At Large Appointments are required to File an Application and Supplemental Forms with Merced County. They are required to be interviewed by the Merced County Board of Supervisors. If selected, are required to file a Form 700, Statement of Economic Interest Form
