BOARD ACTION/DISCUSSION

1. Performance Analysis Report: For period October 1, 2012 to December 31, 2012: Bill Cottle

Mr. Cottle discussed the Fourth Quarter performance report and noted that in the Fourth quarter, the U.S. equity market was mixed on concerns of the election and fiscal cliff. The MCERA portfolio returned a 2.7% during the quarter, outperforming the benchmark return of 2.2% and ranked in the 4th percentile of the total fund universe. Market value increased \$16 million from September 30, 2012 and since inception, the fund has returned 8.1% versus 5.2% for the benchmark. Mr. Cottle also reviewed the watch list noting that WHV is still on the watch list, and Milliman will continue to monitor its performance closely.

2. Report on Due Diligence visit to WHV.

Mr. Cottle discussed his on-site due-diligence meetings with WHV. There have been several meetings with WHV and Mr. Cottle and MCERA staff. Mr. Cottle reported on discussions with the new CEO, Andy Turner, and other members of the firm related to new strategies and personnel changes at WHV. Milliman continues to monitor WHV and report to the Board.

3. Review of Pantheon Private Equity Portfolio: Sprague Von Stroh, Brian Buenneke.

Ms. Von Stroh and Mr. Buenneke presented an update and overview of the firm's organization and investments. Mr. Buenneke also reviewed the performance of MCERA's Pantheon portfolio.

4. **Review of Cost of Living Adjustment rate of 2% as recommended by EFI Actuary**
 In accordance with Section 31870.1 of the County Employees Retirement Law of 1937, MCERA shall determine whether there has been an increase or decrease in the cost of living as provided in this section. EFI recommended a 2% increase in COLA to non-Tier 2 members on April 1, 2013. After discussion, the Board approved the 2% increase.
Motion to approve and adopt a COLA of 2% for April 1, 2013.

 The Board reviewed and discussed the preliminary actuarial results and the proposed employer contribution rate effective July 2013 and directs staff and EFI to proceed with the final Actuarial report which will be presented on March 14, 2013.

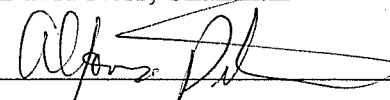
