## MAP ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 21-64 years of age
- No healthcare coverage
- Legal resident of Merced County
- Current Medical Need
- Maximum income of 100% of Federal Poverty Level (FPL)

Medically Indigent Adults (MIAs), ages 21 through 64 who are not pregnant, blind or disabled and who are not eligible for any other coverage through State or Federal aid programs, HMOs, or other comprehensive employer or self paid Health Care Benefits may be considered for medical assistance through MAP. To be eligible the individual must legally reside in Merced County. Undocumented aliens are not eligible for MAP. Refugees living in the County less than 8 months in Handbook are not eligible. They are eligible for Medi-Cal. MAP eligibility is granted on a "medical need basis". To be eligible patients must have a current or ongoing need for medical services as documented by a physician. Eligibility is generally granted for a period ranging from 7 days to 6 months.

Eligibility guidelines similar to medi-cal are used. □□
