



UNDOCUMENTED AND OBAMACARE



Are you undocumented and without health insurance?



YES

NOT ELIGIBLE FOR OBAMACARE. DACA beneficiaries were explicitly excluded from Obamacare. You cannot purchase health insurance through Covered California or receive tax credits.

YOU ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO ENROLL AND YOU WILL NOT GET THE TAX PENALTY

Beware of scams where you're told to enroll in Obamacare or else you will get a tax penalty. That is not true. Undocumented immigrants were excluded from this law so they are not eligible to enroll and will not get a tax penalty.

OTHER OPTIONS:

- Purchase private health insurance (probably not affordable) or gain private coverage through their employer.
- Safety net services like emergency service in hospitals, Charity Care, community clinics.
- Check with your county to see if additional safety net options exist.
