Disposing of medications down the toilet, drain or in the garbage (residential or commercial) is harmful to the environment. You can dispose of your unwanted or expired prescription and non-prescription medications in the **Pharmaceutical Disposal Bin** located in front of the Merced County Sheriff's Department (Main Office)

Please, remove pills from the plastic bottles and place them in a Ziploc bag. We will accept liquids, creams and gels in the original container, just be sure the lids are on tight and they are sealed in a plastic bag.

Please **DO NOT** leave medication outside of the disposal bin, anywhere else on the grounds of the Merced Sherriff's department. All medication **MUST BE PLACED** directly inside of the red disposal bin.



*** Pharmaceuticals can be disposed of, **IN THE RED DISPOSAL BIN ONLY**, anytime, no questions asked!
