# Environmental Compliance Course Descriptions

---

**Basic Hazardous Waste Management:** This 4-hour course provides a general overview of the basics of hazardous waste management for California hazardous waste generators. Training covers waste identification, container and tank management requirements for large and small quantity generators, basic hazardous waste shipping requirements, and the management of contaminated containers and universal waste.

**Universal Waste Management:** This 2-hour course covers identification of universal waste, spill response, and proper storage, labeling, shipping, recycling, and recordkeeping requirements.

**Hazardous Materials Business Plans / CERS:** This 4-hour program covers applicability, completion, submittal, and employee training requirements for facilities that are required to prepare a Hazardous Materials Business Plan because they store hazardous materials at their facility. The program includes navigating and using the California Environmental Reporting System (CERS).

**SPCC Plans for APSA Sites:** Designed for facilities that store > 1,320 gallons of petroleum products (fuels, oils, solvents, etc.) in aboveground tanks, this 2-hour course covers regulated facilities and materials, state statutes, recordkeeping, training requirements, and Spill Prevention, Control, and Countermeasure Plans.

**Advanced Hazardous Waste Management:** The advanced program is an 8-hour course that goes beyond basic hazardous waste training by expanding upon those topics covered in the basic program and including hazardous waste recordkeeping requirements, waste identification and classification, Land Disposal Restrictions, and tiered permitting requirements for waste treatment.

**DOT & Hazardous Waste Manifest:** This is an 8-hour course for employees who are responsible for preparing and/or signing manifests for hazardous waste shipments. Training covers identification of the DOT hazard classes and divisions, use of the DOT Haz Mat table, selection of appropriate shipping names, and proper packaging, marking, labeling, and placarding for DOT-regulated waste shipments. The course also covers the completion, distribution, and retention of the Uniform Hazardous Waste Manifest for RCRA and non-RCRA hazardous waste.
