Things to know when you apply:

1. Social security numbers for applicants who are U.S. citizens, or document information for immigrants with satisfactory status who need insurance. Proof of citizenship or immigration status is only required for applicants.
2. Families that include immigrants can apply. You can apply for your child even if you aren't eligible for coverage. Applying for your eligible child won't affect your immigration status or chances of becoming a permanent resident or citizen.
3. Employer and income information for everyone in your family.
4. Your federal tax information. If you do not file taxes you may still qualify for free or low-cost insurance through Medi-Cal.
5. Information about health insurance that you or any family member gets through a job.
