MERCED COUNTY MOSQUITO ABATEMENT DISTRICT

TERM OF OFFICE - TWO (2 or 4) YEARS

District was formed by Board September 2, 1923. This Board is required to file Form 700-Statement of Economic Interest. Board appointees are required to complete an application for appointment and Supplemental per Board Action on 2/26/2008 - Resolution No. 2008-28.

Initial terms of office for trustees of MADs and VCDs are established as two years, with one-half of the terms expiring each year on the common date of the second day of the calendar year next succeeding their appointment. Each successive reappointment, if any, may be for a term of two or four years, at the discretion of the appointing power. New members may be appointed by the appropriate body to fill a vacancy during the term, but must be re-appointed at the common term expiration date in spite of serving for less than a full term.

PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVE

Created under the provision of "An Act to provide for the formation, government, operation and dissolution of Mosquito Abatement Districts in a part of the state to facilitate the extermination of mosquitoes, flies, and other insects; and to provide for the assessment, levy, collection and disbursement of taxes therein" approved May 29, 1915, California State Legislature.

MEMBERSHIP

The Board makes three appointments and each City within Merced County has one appointment. Board appointments as follows:

- 1. County Member At Large
- 2. County Northern Rural
- 3. County Western Rural

(This Board requires a Notary Public Appointment Form and Letter.)
