## TERM OF OFFICE PLEASURE OF THE BOARD

Established by Board Action on March 31, 1998 for development of the Proposition 204 Animal Confinement Facility Loan Program. This committee is required by FPPC to complete a Form 700-Statement of Economic Interests. Board action of May 3, 2011 – County Counsel removed as a voting member of the Committee.

## **PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVE**

To review and approve/deny loans based on the approved guidelines and rules outlined in the adopted Merced County Agricultural Waste Management Loan Program Guidelines.

## **MEMBERSHIP**

The Committee shall consist of six (5) members appointed by the Board of Supervisors, one from each of the following categories:

- 1. Administration
- 2. Auditor-Controller
- 3. Business-Economic Opportunities
- 4. Environmental Health
- 5. Animal Industry
