This included DACA requirements, history, and facts.</li><li>• DACA is an executive action by President Obama, the next President could change it.</li><li>• As a note, kids applying for DACA need proof of residency during the summertime (this is hard when they are not in school). If you host a community event or class be sure to provide a certificate or proof of attendance so they can use this as documentation.</li><li>• DACA 2014 is stalled in litigation.</li><li>• A toolkit is available online.</li><li>• There are over 800,000 DACA youth nationwide.</li></ul>
