The state legislature has indicated that they will not be addressing health care coverage for adults this legislative year. This year PAT team is working on advocating for health coverage for undocumented adults. Meetings are the first Thursday of the month from 2-4pm at United Way in Merced.</p>

A – CCAH will ask DHCS for a list or report</p> <p>1095 B mixed status families cannot correct data or forms; individuals can self-attest but Human Services Agency does not have the capability to unlock and edit the form</p> <p>Human Services Agency receives an alert for the month when kids turn 19, but their eligibility is determined prior to that time. When a child turns 19 their code moves to an adult aid code (similar when an adult turns from 64 to 65).</p>
