<b>Last Day for Measure Consolidation (Requested Deadline)</b>  <b>August 1, 2017</b> <b>E-98</b>	<b>Resolution Requesting Measure Consolidation</b> - must be submitted to the Board of Supervisors; a copy of the resolution is to be provided to the Registrar of Voters (ROV).  <b>Resolution to include:</b> Request for ROV to provide services, ballot question (75 word limit), passage requirements, full text (including Tax Rate Statement and Fiscal Impact Report, if applicable). <b>Cities</b> - Impartial Analysis to be filed with resolution. <b>Schools &amp; Districts</b> – County elections official will request Analysis. <span style="color: blue;">EC§9160, 9222, 9280, 9313, 9500,</span>
<b>August 2 – August 9</b> <b>E-97 – E-90</b>	<b>Publication</b> – Notice of election date, ballot question, primary & rebuttal argument deadlines: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>County, School &amp; Special District Measures</b>, the required notice will be published by the Registrar of Voters. <span style="color: blue;">EC§9163, 9502</span></li> <li>• <b>Municipal Measures</b>, the <b>City Clerk</b> will publish the required notice. <span style="color: blue;">EC§9286, 12102</span></li> </ul>
<b>August 2 – August 11</b> <b>E-97 – E-88</b>	<b>10-Day Public Examination Period of Measure</b> <span style="color: blue;">EC§9190, 9380, 9286, 9295, 9509</span>
<b>Late Period Measure Consolidation (Legal Deadline)</b>  <b>August 2 – August 11</b> <b>E-97 - E-88</b>	<b>Late Period - Measure Consolidation Requests</b> Measure Consolidations received after the Requested Deadline through 5:00 p.m. on the Legal Deadline (E-88) are considered Late Period Requests. Argument filing deadlines will be adjusted and shortened to allow for publication, receipt of arguments, public examination periods, translations, and preparation of official voter materials prior to the first day for Military and Overseas ballot mailings.
<b>August 16, 2017</b> <b>5:00 p.m. on E-83</b>	<b>Deadline: <u>Primary</u> Arguments In Favor or Against</b> Argument deadlines may be different for City Measures, in non-statewide elections, check with the City Clerk. If measure is filed <b>after E-98 (8/1)</b> , <b>deadline will be adjusted to E-78 (8/21)</b> . <span style="color: blue;">GC§57146; EC§9162, 9286(b), 9316, 9502</span>
<b>August 16, 2017</b> <b>E-83</b>	<b>Deadline: Amendment or Withdrawal of Measure</b> The governing body may amended or withdrawn a measure by filing of a resolution with the elections official. If the measure qualified by the initiative or referendum process, a written withdrawal notice signed by all proponents must be filed. <span style="color: blue;">EC§9604, 9605</span>
<b>August 17 – August 28</b> <b>E-82 – E-71</b>	<b>10-Day Public Examination Period for Primary Arguments</b> (Deadline adjusted for weekend.) <span style="color: blue;">EC§9190, 9380, 9286, 9295, 9509</span>
<b>August 25</b> <b>5:00 p.m. on E-74</b>	<b>Deadline: <u>Rebuttal</u> to Arguments In Favor or Against</b> There will only be a rebuttal argument filing period, if both an argument in favor <u>and</u> an argument against are filed during the primary argument period. <b>August 26 – September 4</b> <b>E-73 – E-64</b>	<b>10-Day Public Examination Period for Rebuttal Arguments</b> <span style="color: blue;">EC§9190, 9380, 9286, 9295, 9509</span>
<b>September 8, 2017</b> <b>E-60</b>	<b>Military &amp; Overseas Voter Information &amp; Ballot Mailing starts</b> <span style="color: blue;">EC§3105</span>
<b>November 7, 2017</b>	<b>Election Day</b> <span style="color: blue;">EC§1000</span>
