

NOTICE TO TAXPAYERS OF MERCED  
COUNTY FOR UNSECURED TAXES



Unsecured tax bills were mailed on July 30, 2019 to the addresses shown on the unsecured tax roll.

**An Unsecured Tax generally refers to property that can be relocated and is not real property.**

The tax is assessed against such property as business personal property/fixtures, boats and airplanes.

**Failure to receive a tax bill shall not relieve the lien of taxes, nor shall it prevent penalties from being imposed by California Revenue & taxation code § 2610.5**

Taxes on the unsecured tax roll as of July 30, 2019 if unpaid are delinquent August 31, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. and, thereafter, a 10% penalty attaches to them. Unpaid taxes accrue penalties of 1½% per month beginning November 1, 2019.
