Demonstrate rescue breathing techniques when using a pocket face mask or mouth to mouth maneuver. f. Demonstrate Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) for adults, children and infants, individually and in pairs. g. Identify symptoms of a heart attack. h.
