Performance Objectives

To the satisfaction of the instructor, trainees will be able to: a) Accurately explain the Use of Force & Less than Lethal Policy and how it applies to facility disturbances. Pass written test with 80% or higher. b) Correctly demonstrate and participate in pre-extraction planning and briefing. c) Correctly select and apply protective equipment to control team. d) Identify and describe all positions on the control team and their responsibilities. Identify critical (team filled) and non-critical (staff filled) positions e) Demonstrate the proper use of video equipment for documentation of disturbance. f) Demonstrate the safe extraction and restraining of inmates from affected areas (Redman Drill) using the lowest Use of Force methods available. g) Demonstrate proper entry tactics into a linear styled cell block, using protective shields, distraction devises and or less than lethal munitions. h) Demonstrate proper entry techniques for protecting team members from inmate assault through the bars and adjacent cells. i) Demonstrate alternate methods for removing inmates from general purpose rooms, exercise yards, and holding cells. j) Articulate and demonstrate the required tasks to be used after less-than-lethal devices have been implemented. k) Explain the reasons for obtaining medical clearance for inmate(s), as well as report injuries to staff after an extraction. l) Correctly demonstrate and participate in post-extraction debriefing.
