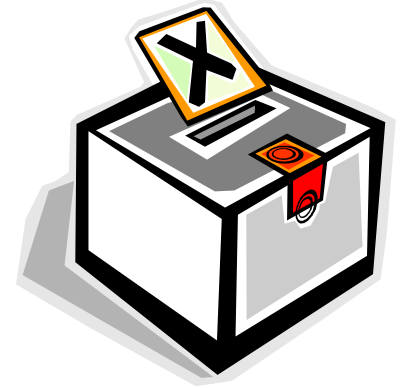

Where to obtain your polling location:

- Sample Ballot Pamphlet: Located on back page of pamphlet
- Online Polling Place Look-up: Visit www.mercedelections.org
- By phone: Contact our office at 209-385-7541
- In Person: Visit our office located at the County Administration Building, 2222 M Street, Room 14, Merced, CA 95340

Please note that your polling location may change from previous elections.

What if I am unable to vote at my polling location on Election Day?



Permanent Vote by Mail Ballot:

- Ballots are automatically sent to Vote by Mail voters each election.

Single Request Vote by Mail Ballot (One-time Request):

- All registered voters may obtain a Vote by Mail ballot in person, or by mail.

Please note that Vote by Mail ballots are not released until 29 days prior to Election Day. Requests submitted by mail must be received 7 days prior to the election. Requests in person may be submitted at the counter of the Registrar of Voters until 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.

What if I'm active military or an overseas voter?



Use one of the following forms:

- FPCA-Federal Post Card Application
- FWAB-Federal Write-in Absentee Ballot
- Local Permanent or Single Request Vote by Mail Ballot Application are acceptable if properly registered to vote in Merced County.
